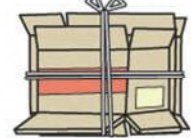


### Old Cloth/Clothing

Bundle with cord according to type



Magazines, newspaper and brochure inserts



Cardboard

Place in transparent or semi-transparent bag



Old cloth, clothing, sheets and blankets

Items filled with cotton wadding or feathers are treated as oversized garbage.

If cloth or clothing items get wet, they cannot be recycled. If it is raining on the day of collection, please wait until the next collection day to put your items out.

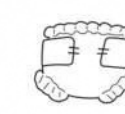

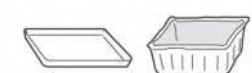

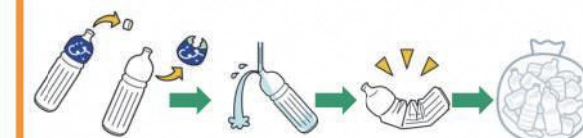

### Plastic PET Bottles

Dispose of cap and label as plastic container and wrapping; rinse out plastic PET bottles, crush, and place in a transparent bag

### Used Small Appliances



Items that do not fit in a collection box (10 cm x 27 cm) but measure under 30cm should be disposed of as noncombustible garbage; those larger than 30cm on any side should be disposed of as oversized garbage

### Milk Cartons



Cut open, rinse and dry.

### Ink Cartridges



Only official ink cartridges with the label of one of the following printer manufacturers are accepted.

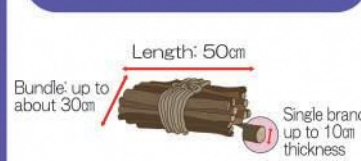
### Oversized Garbage



Combustible or noncombustible items measuring 30cm or more on any side, used small appliances, etc.

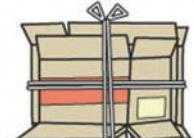
