Transportation Information

The map illustrates the Kiyose area, a key transportation hub in Tokyo. It shows the following lines and stations:

- JR Musashino Line:** Runs vertically through the center, with stations like Hon-Kawagoe, Tokorozawa, Shin-Akitsu, and Kokubunji.
- Seibu Ikebukuro Line:** Runs horizontally across the top, connecting Kiyose (SI15) to Ikebukuro (SI01).
- Seibu Shinjuku Line:** Connects Kiyose (SI15) to Shinjuku (SS01) via Kodaira and Takadanobaba (SS02).

- JR Chuo Line:** Runs horizontally at the bottom, connecting Hachioji to Nakano.

- Kiyose (SI15):** The central station, highlighted in red.
- Shin-Akitsu:** A major station on the JR Musashino Line.
- Kodaira:** A major station on the Seibu Shinjuku Line.
- Takadanobaba (SS02):** A major station on the Seibu Shinjuku Line and JR Yamanote Line.
- Shinjuku (SS01):** A major station on the Seibu Shinjuku Line and JR Yamanote Line.
- Ikebukuro (SI01):** A major station on the Seibu Ikebukuro Line and JR Yamanote Line.
- Hannō:** A station on the Seibu Ikebukuro Line.
- Higashi-Hannō:** A station on the Seibu Ikebukuro Line.
- Nishi-Tokorozawa:** A station on the Seibu Ikebukuro Line.
- Tokorozawa:** A station on the Seibu Ikebukuro Line.

① Seibu Ikebukuro Line to Kiyose Station, North Exit, 2nd Bus Platform (#61 bus) direction to Shiki Station South Exit. Get off at Greentown Kiyoto, walk 6 minutes.

- ② Tobu Tojo Line to Shiki Station South Exit, 3rd Bus Platform (#61 bus) direction to Kiyose North Exit. Get off at Shitajuku Iriguchi, walk 3 minutes.

On Foot
From Kiyose Station
