



# Kiyose City's Sunflower Fields



Kiyose City is located in the Tokyo suburbs, blessed with natural environments where many agricultural lands and greenery still remains. In summertime, around 100,000 sunflowers appear in approximately 24,000m<sup>2</sup> of large agricultural lands.

The sunflower field is open to the public for a limited period of time because the farmland owner

cultivates sunflowers

as green manure and it is a very beautiful landscape.

This festival is held every year with the cooperation and good will of Ishii Farm (Mr. Yoshiteru Ishii), Kodera Farm (Mr. Kouichi Kodera), and local residents. This festival is representative of "Kiyose City's agricultural scenery".

#### Bus

- 1 Seibu Ikebukuro Line to Kiyose Station, North Exit, 2nd Bus Platform (#61 bus) direction to Shiki Station South Exit.Get off at Greentown Kiyoto, walk 6 minutes.
- 2 Tobu Tojo Line to Shiki Station South Exit, 3rd Bus Platform (#61 bus) direction to Kiyose North Exit. Get off at Shitajuku Iriguchi, walk 3 minutes.
